We are looking for a **Maths Teacher** in a school that offers excellent opportunities for professional development. Twyford Church of England High School, an Ofsted outstanding school with a thriving Sixth Form, is one of four **Twyford Trust** schools, and the new post-holder will be joining us at a time of growth. The organisation therefore offers good promotion prospects for motivated and energetic teachers who support the ethos of our schools. The post is well suited to experienced teachers, and we are able to offer a key stage responsibility or other responsibility post, for the right candidate. The role is also suitable for NQTs and RQTs.

Our KS3 and KS4 Maths curriculums are three tiered, using differentiated outcomes for each lesson to ensure we deliver the best possible curriculum for students of all abilities. At KS5, we run A Level courses in both Maths and Further Maths, and student recruitment to these courses has been an area of growth for the school. The curriculum and assessment frameworks are stored on the VLE ('Copia') to ensure that all materials are accessible for students, parents and staff.

The department comprises 16 teachers, led by the head of department and Key Stage Coordinators. The department includes 3 trainees, with many of the team having additional responsibilities across the school. The successful candidate would teach groups from all key stages; all teachers in the department are required to teach Maths to KS5.
